

Colossians Remixed - Facilitator: Rolan DeLoach in the Coggin Room

The goal of this study will be to understand Paul's letter in order to be more fully equipped to live our daily lives as followers of the Lord Jesus Christ. Primarily, we will explore Paul's letter through the lens of "Colossians Remixed", a book written by Brian J. Walsh and Sylvia C. Keesmatt. This text looks at Colossians in its historical context of being an explosive and subversive force to the Roman empire. They believe that today we need to see this radical vision of Paul's letter then remix it in the context of our present day world.
