## Joshua 11:21-23; 13:1-7

<sup>21</sup> At that time Joshua went and destroyed the Anakites from the hill country: from Hebron, Debir and Anab, from all the hill country of Judah, and from all the hill country of Israel. Joshua totally destroyed them and their towns. <sup>22</sup> No Anakites were left in Israelite territory; only in Gaza, Gath and Ashdod did any survive.

<sup>23</sup> So Joshua took the entire land, just as the LORD had directed Moses, and he gave it as an inheritance to Israel according to their tribal divisions. Then the land had rest from war.

## Joshua 13:1-7

When Joshua had grown old, the LORD said to him, "You are now very old, and there are still very large areas of land to be taken over.

<sup>2</sup> "This is the land that remains: all the regions of the Philistines and Geshurites, <sup>3</sup> from the Shihor River on the east of Egypt to the territory of Ekron on the north, all of it counted as Canaanite though held by the five Philistine rulers in Gaza, Ashdod, Ashkelon, Gath and Ekron; the territory of the Avvites <sup>4</sup> on the south; all the land of the Canaanites, from Arah of the Sidonians as far as Aphek and the border of the Amorites; <sup>5</sup> the area of Byblos; and all Lebanon to the east, from Baal Gad below Mount Hermon to Lebo Hamath.

<sup>6</sup> "As for all the inhabitants of the mountain regions from Lebanon to Misrephoth Maim, that is, all the Sidonians, I myself will drive them out before the Israelites. Be sure to allocate this land to Israel for an inheritance, as I have instructed you, <sup>7</sup> and divide it as an inheritance among the nine tribes and half of the tribe of Manasseh."
